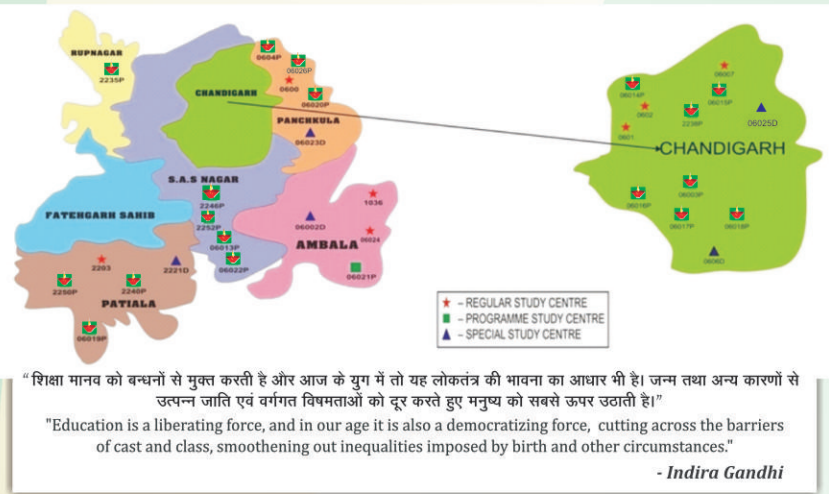

REGIONAL CENTRE CHANDIGARH

A large segment of the society was deprived from access to higher education due to geo-physical, socio-economic and ethno-cultural setting of the country. Moreover, the existing conventional education system remains to be costly, rigid in admission rules, lacks flexibility in terms of place, pace and duration of study. Precisely, it was in this context that the govt. of India had revolutionized the structure of higher education by introducing the bill in parliament in 1985 to establish first National Open University (IGNOU) with the objective to offer innovative and need based, cost effective and high quality education by using latest Information & Communication Technologies (ICT). While developing the programmes, special emphasis was laid down to “reach the hitherto unreached areas” without compromising the social objective and quality benchmarks. As a result of this, today in IGNOU, there are around 3000 Learner Support Centres, 67 Regional Centres and 3.032 million students enrolled in 232 programmes in and outside the India. IGNOU has also acquired international role by establishing Learner Support Centres in 29 overseas countries. At present total enrolment in the country in higher education is 28.51 million and out of which 3.032 million are enrolled in IGNOU which is 10.63 percent of the total enrolment of the country. Though, India has the second largest education system, the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in the country is 23.6 per cent, the way below the world average of the 30 percent and in some of the developed countries such as USA with 34, UK 59, Japan 55 and China 28 percent. Therefore, a lot of efforts are required to achieve the higher GER. Open and Distance Learning (ODL) system, particularly IGNOU with its vast network can play a pivotal role to achieve the target.

REGIONAL CENTRE CHANDIGARH: A GLANCE

In order to strengthen its student support services in and around tri-city of Chandigarh, Mohali and Panchkula and adjoining districts of Punjab and Haryana, Indira Gandhi National Open University, established Regional Centre at Chandigarh on 1st January, 2009 by carving out a few Learners Support Centres of Chandigarh and adjoining districts of Punjab & Haryana including Panchkula and Ambala, Mohali, Patiala and Fatehgarh Sahab. The important towns served by this Regional Centre are Panchkula, Kalka, Pinjore, Ambala, Barwala, Mohali, Sirhind, Ropar, Nangal, Nabha, Zirakpur & Patiala. Although the operational area of the Regional Centre is relatively small, however, it enrolls about ten thousand students to the various programmes of the university on yearly basis. Initially the number of LSCs attached were very few, but considering the interest of the learners in IGNOU programmes a significant number of Learner Support Centres were established over the years. The Jurisdiction of Regional Centre was bifurcated from Regional Centre Khanna and Karnal which are catering the Open and Distance Learning needs of the states of Punjab and Haryana respectively. It is one of the fast upcoming Regional Centres in the country in terms of student enrolment, number of Learner Support Centres, programmes activated and various decentralized operational functions. Since then with the consistent efforts, the enrolment of various programmes has been increasing steadily and in 2017 it is likely to cross ten thousand. The Regional Centre is making all efforts to provide best support services to its learners with a network of 31 active LSC's in the region. As a result, in every convocation, some students of this RC awarded university gold medal for best performance in a particular programme.

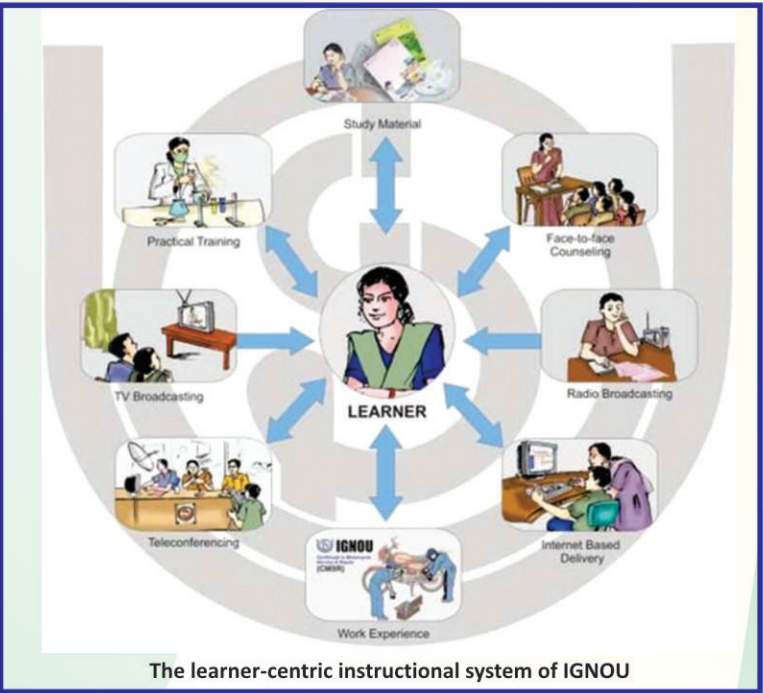
Feedback from IGNOU Gold Medalist

PROGRAMMES ON OFFER

All the major programmes of the university are also on offer from RC which includes 31 Master Degree, 12 Bachelor Degree including BPP, BA, BCOM, BSW, BCA, BLISc, and BTS, 36 PG Diploma/ Diploma and 32 Certificate programmes. The popular programmes at the Master degree are Anthropology, Psychology, Tourism & Travel Management, Social Work, Rural Development, M.Sc. in Dietetics & Food Service Management, MBA, MCA & MLISc besides MA in Social Sciences & Humanities. See our website: www.ignou.ac.in for more details about the Programmes on offer.

Mode of Admissions: Except some specified programmes, the admission is offered both in January and July Sessions for which applications are invited during March-June and September to December, respectively, through online admission process. The link for the same is made available on the University website: www.ignou.ac.in. The information is disseminated among the masses by using various modes which include advertisement in the prominent dailies in English, Hindi and Punjabi, press releases, distribution of leaflets and pamphlets, organizing admission camps and SMS to the prospective learners.

Medium of Instruction: Majority of the programmes are offered in Hindi and English, however some of the programmes are also offered in regional languages. Migration is not required at the time of admission for any programme however, IGNOU issues Migration Certificate after successful completion of the programme.

Important Schedule of Activities

Admission through online link: IGNOU has two cycle of admission for July and January Session. Admission related information is also disseminated by making best use of the ICT. Admission to the majority of the programmes is done through online link available on the university website www.ignou.ac.in. Generally the admission link is open in the beginning of the session and remains active till last date is over.

Admission through Entrance: Admission to some of the programmes is based on the merit obtained in the entrance test conducted by the university. For instance, the entrance test for admission to MBA is conducted twice in February & August every year & BED & BSCN (PB) once in August. University also releases national and regional advertisement for the entrance test. The schedule of the entrance test is also made available on the website.

Re-registration: Students of all two/ three year Master/Bachelor (Annual / Semester) programmes have to take re- registration as per University schedule through online link. The tentative schedule is:
For January Session (1st August to 1st October) & For July Session (1st February to 31st

March). However, there is a provision of late fee also upto 20th June/ December.
Re admission: ODL system provide considerable flexibility for the learners to complete the programme even after the completion of the maximum duration. Therefore, students can take re-admission for completing the remaining/ left-over courses. The schedule is same for all Programmes i.e. between 1st August to 1st October (for January Session) & 1st February to 1st April (for July Session). Form & Guidelines are available on the IGNOU Website.

Continuous Evaluation System: Student's performance is evaluated continuously through assignments, practical and Term End Examination and Project work/Internship. Students are expected to download the latest assignments of their respective courses from the university website and submit the same at the Study Centres as per the schedule given in the assignment. University conducts Term End Examination twice in a year in the month of June and December. Students are expected to submit examination forms through the online link available on the university website. Filling up of Exam Forms for TEE June (1st to 31st March) & for TEE December (1st to 30th September). However, there is a provision of late fee (upto15 Nov/15May) also for TEE. Practical Examination: University also conduct practical examination twice in a year and for appearing in the practical examination 70 percent attendance in the practical is compulsory. Project work: In some of the programmes project work is also assigned to the learners. Detailed modalities for pursuing project work is given in the respective programme guide.
